The Exhibition Space: The Cranberry Township Municipal building, located at 2525 Rochester Road, Cranberry Township, PA 16066.

Awards: Cranberry Artists Network will provide Certificates of Excellence awards along with cash awards.

Registration:

- \$20 for up to two pieces of art
- For all entries, please register and send your entrance fee via PayPal through our website: www.cranberryartistsnetwork.com/spring2025 no later than Sunday, February 16, 2025 at 8:59 p.m.

Entry Regulations:

- Only current CAN members in good standing may enter the show.
- Artists are permitted to submit 1-2 pieces of art for entry in any medium (except film or video and installations).
- Artwork must have been produced within the last 3 years and not have previously been shown in Cranberry Township.
- Original artwork only (no reproductions).
- 2-D works must be professionally presented and ready to hang.
 No sawtooth hangers, picture wire and mounting hardware securely attached to frame only, not the backing. Pieces with unsecure wiring will be rejected at drop-off.
- 3-D works must be exhibit ready.
- Maximum width 36" including frame, portrait or landscape. Please note: these dimensions are absolute, artwork & frame wider than 36" will be rejected.
- Please note: These dimensions must include the frame for paintings.
 The depth dimensions will also apply for sculptures, ceramics, pottery and tapestries. Sculpture base and diameter no larger than 20". Any artwork that does not comply will be rejected.

- All work must have 2 registration tags attached to the back of the work upon delivery. (See page 3 of the prospectus for registration tags.)
- Digital registration only.
- All entries must be accompanied by a clear, focused picture of the submitted artwork.
- Entry pictures must be in JPEG format with at least 72 dpi and should not exceed 5MB.

Notification of Acceptance

 Notification of acceptance will be sent via email on or about Sunday, February 23, 2025.

Drop Off:

- Accepted artwork must be dropped off to be hung on Thursday, February 27, 2025 between 4 and 7pm at municipal building. No early drop offs.
- All artwork must hang for the duration of the show!

Pick Up:

Artwork must be picked up on Thursday, April 10, 2025 between 4 p.m. and 7 p.m. at the municipal building. No early pickups. Artwork not picked up within the scheduled date & time will be placed in storage at the artist's risk and expense. A \$25 storage fee will be assessed.
 Artworks remaining after 30 days become the property of CAN.

Disclaimer: The Cranberry Township Municipal Center is a public space. Cranberry Artists Network and the Cranberry Township Municipal Center will take reasonable precautions to prevent damage, theft or loss of artwork, but will not be held responsible for the aforementioned. By submitting artwork into the show, the artist agrees to these terms.

Sales: Cranberry Artists Network will conduct all sales during the exhibition. Artists retain 80% of the sale. Cranberry Artists Network retains the right to use art images for any promotional materials.





Below is a list of the duties for each position.

Exhibitions Chair

- A. The Exhibitions Chair shall be responsible for arranging exhibits for the member shows and other special exhibitions with Cranberry Township.
- B. The Exhibition Chair will be responsible for confirming the exhibition space with Cranberry Township. He/she will arrange for refreshments tables, and display board setup.
- C. Exhibition will be in contact with the CAN publicity chair.
- D. Choose the juror for the show when necessary.
- E. Be present for work drop-off, sign-in and hanging.
- F. Be present for work pick-up and sign-out sheet.
- G. The Exhibitions Chair will form a committee which may consist of active members to assist with the CAN exhibitions.
- H. The Exhibitions Chair will report all information related to CAN exhibitions at CAN Board Meetings
- I. Will organize, schedule & oversee Back Hall Gallery & display case

Treasurer

- A. The Treasurer and a designated board member shall receive and disburse all the funds of the organization under the direction of the Board of Directors.
- B. Be responsible for the maintenance and safekeeping of all financial records of CAN.
- C. Make a financial report at each CAN Board meeting and at any designated business meeting.
- D. Maintain a list of basic yearly expenses and provide the Reimbursement Form to Board Members for Board approved expenses.
- E. Make and record all deposits and payments.
- F. Ensures development and board review of financial policies and procedures.

Program/Education Chair

- A. The Program/Education Chair shall be responsible for arranging programs for the bi-annual General Membership Meetings and other educational events.
- B. Contact Cranberry Township for program dates and available meeting/program spaces.
- C. Provide and receive contracts from artists who are presenting.
- D. Distribute write-ups and information about programs.
- E. The Program/Education Chair will report all information related to programs and education at CAN Board meetings.
