- No registration payments will be accepted during the drop off.

Entry Regulations:

- Only current CAN members in good standing may enter the show.
- Artists are permitted to submit 1-2 pieces of art for entry in any medium (except film or video and installations).
- Artwork must have been produced within the last 3 years and not have previously been shown in Cranberry Township.
- Original Artwork only (no reproductions).
- 2-D works must be professionally presented and ready to hang. No sawtooth hangers, picture wire and mounting hardware securely attached to frame only, not the backing. Pieces with unsecure wiring will be rejected at drop-off.
- 3-D works must be exhibit ready.
- Size limitations 36" W x 50" H including frame. Please note: these dimensions are absolute, artwork & frame wider than 36" will be rejected.
- Please note: These dimensions must include the frame for paintings. The depth dimensions will also apply for sculptures, ceramics, pottery and tapestries. Any artwork that does not comply will be rejected.

- All work must have 2 registration tags attached to the back of the work upon delivery. (See page 2 of the prospectus for registration tags.)
- Digital registration only.
- All entries must be accompanied by a clear, focused picture of the submitted artwork.
- Entry pictures must be in JPEG format with at least 72dpi and should not exceed 5MB.

Notification of Acceptance

 Notification of acceptance will be sent via email on or about Sunday, February 26, 2023

Drop Off:

- Accepted artwork must be dropped off to be hung on Thursday, March 2, 2023 between 4 and 7pm at the Municipal Center.
- Artwork must hang for the duration of the show.

Pick Up:

 Artwork must be picked up on Thursday, April 20, 2023 between 4 p.m. and 7 p.m. at the Municipal Center. Artwork not picked up within the scheduled return date will be placed in storage at the artist's risk and expense. A \$25 storage fee will be assessed. Artworks remaining after 30 days become the property of CAN.

Entry Procedures

- Open to all artists 18 years of age or older.
- Maximum of 6 entries per artist and entries may not have been displayed at the Dressler Center for at least the port 3 team.
- Por 1 <u>x entries</u>: Non-orfandable los of \$25 made populár to *Learet Arts*.
- <u>For a 6 entries</u>: Non-orfundable for of \$35 made payable to Langel Arts.
- Artwork should be original and able to stand security.
- All hanging activities amust be properly wired for hanging. No azortoith hangers.

- For freestanding pieces, the only size reatriction are the doorways at 32° and there are 4-7 steps depending on which entrance you use.
- <u>Tanp</u> printed submission can'ts must accompany each entry (see example boase) and include artist's name, address, phone, till or work, medium and price or NFS (8) not for sale).
- Attach one card to the back of each entry and provide the other card to staff.
- Artists must offer at least one-hulf of their submissions for sale.
- For 3 submissions, 2 would be for sale For 5 submissions, 3 would be for sale.
- Laurel Arts will transact all sales and sales tax. We will also retain a 30% commission on gallery sales. Please price your work accordingly.
- All work must be signed in at drop off and signed out at pick up with staff.
- All extrins will be handled with care, however the Philip Dressler Center for the Arts is not respenable: for any loss or damage.
