



LOOKING FOR A MAKEOVER

Mary Jane Hadley (watercolor on paper, 171/2x231/2)

I took my mom's ladder-back chair to get the seat recaned. Entering the warehouse, I saw several aisles of furniture in disrepair. The shapes, textures and directional lines inspired

interesting compositions.

I created Looking for a Makeover using a limited palette of yellow, red and blue. I covered the lightest value areas I wanted to save with masking fluid. Using a mouth atomizer, I sprayed the entire paper with quinacridone gold. While it was still wet, I sprayed quinacridone magenta in areas where I wanted the colors to mix. After letting it dry, I added masking fluid to cover areas that would remain yellow, orange and a deep red. Then with the mouth atomizer, I sprayed Prussian blue to achieve my darkest value. All the masking fluid was then removed. I finished the painting with a brush using phthalo bluegreen, new gamboge and titanium buff.

Mary Jane Hadley's "Waiting for a Makeover" was selected as a FINALIST by Awards Juror, Stephen Zhang, in Splash 26: The best of Watercoloor Art Competition. It is in newsstands now!!




