

At CURIO student artists who are ages 6-12 will immerse themselves in a 4-day intensive, exciting, art education course that covers a wide array of art making techniques, skills, and media. Artists will be exposed to ceramics, painting, drawing, mixed media, printmaking, and more. Class will run Tuesday through Friday, for two hours each day, from 9:30 - 11:30 am. Artists will be separated into 2 studios by age and ability level to work with artists at their skill level. This ensures that each artist receives age-appropriate instruction, encouragement and enrichment!

### Monster stitches:

Let your imagination run wild in this hands-on summer art camp where young creators bring their own monster friends to life! Children will learn essential hand-sewing techniques while crafting a one-of-a-kind plush monster using colorful felt and embroidery materials. Starting with basic pattern-making, campers will choose their monster's body shape and add personality through hand-stitched facial features. Want tentacles? Extra eyes? A spiky tail? Each young artist will take home their handmade monster friend along with valuable sewing skills they can use for future projects.

### Summer stitches:

In this hands-on course students ages 8-15 will learn the enchanting art of crochet while

creating charming summer-themed projects. Instructor Miss Brandy will guide both beginners and intermediate crocheters through engaging projects in a fun, supportive environment.

Beginner and Intermediate Levels:

- Learn essential crochet stitches: single crochet, slip stitch, double crochet and the Magic Ring.
- Create colorful crocheted bracelets
- Learn to read basic patterns and understand crochet terminology
- Make an adorable beginner-friendly Amigurumi fruit character

All materials are provided, including high-quality yarn in summer-inspired colors, crochet

hooks, copies of patterns and plenty of creative inspiration. Students will take home their finished projects along with the skills to continue crocheting long after camp ends.

Each year, regional artists compete for a chance to exhibit in this annual show, held in the Hart Galleries of the historic Stifel Fine Arts Center. Works are chosen by a guest juror. Cash prizes awarded to winning artists.

Eligibility: Open to all artists 18 years or older, working in any media. Artists must reside in West Virginia, Ohio, Pennsylvania, Kentucky, Maryland and Virginia. Artists may submit up to three works completed within the last calendar year which have not been previously exhibited at the Stifel Fine Arts Center.

Awards: \$750 in first, second and third prizes will be awarded at the discretion of the juror.
